- abstracts must be submitted in English (British spelling)
- graphs and pictures can be inserted as JPG, GIF or PNG image formats only
- fill in the author's name and e-mail address properly - these contact details will be used in all further correspondence
- please choose the topic of your abstract (you can choose 1 topic only)
- indicate the preferred way of presentation - oral or poster
- indicate if you are Invited Speaker

Abstract Layout Instructions

- the abstract has to be as informative as possible
- use 11 point Times New Roman font and single line spacing throughout the whole abstract
- use left alignment
- type the body of the abstract using a free paper structure as follows:
 - Objective
 - Methods
 - Results
 - Conclusion
- maximum length of the abstract is 2000 characters, the number is checked automatically by the system
- abstract title must be in bold and in CAPITAL letters ****
- check spelling and grammar carefully - direct reproduction from your electronically sent abstract text means that any errors in spelling, grammar or scientific data will be reproduced as submitted
- only standard abbreviations may be used

To submit your abstract, log in to the on-line system for abstracts (using password you have received after filling in the Personal Data Form on: www.icd2009.com).

CONGRESS VENUE - Prague Congress Centre



The ICD 2009 Congress will be held at the Prague Congress Centre (PCC) which is ideally located near the city centre with a panoramic view of Prague Castle. It is easily accessible by both public and private transport. It has its own metro station and extensive parking facilities.

The Prague Congress Centre is one of the largest and best equipped European centres.
